Modern society is facing an active digital transformation of the public administration system, which is particularly connected to the use of advanced technological tools in this field such as on-line services and BlockChain databases. This has resulted in a rapid transformation of the legal basis for implementing up-to-date management and solutions in the digital field. However, the complexity of implementing these transformations in a timely manner often significantly slows down practical application of digital technologies with the intention of improving

the effectiveness of public relations regulation by the state. In fact, such transformations should be systemic because of the multi-level composition of the national legal system.

This panel discussion aims to raise the issue of the developing legal basis for digital technologies application in the field of public administration and to suggest potential solutions.
